The battery uses vanadium's ability to exist in a solution in four different oxidation states to make a battery with a single electroactive element instead of two. [6] For several reasons, including their relative bulkiness, vanadium batteries are typically used for grid energy storage, i.e., attached to power plants/electrical grids. [7]

One of the most promising energy storage device in comparison to other battery technologies is vanadium redox flow battery because of the following characteristics: high-energy efficiency, long life cycle, simple maintenance, prodigious flexibility for variable energy and power requirement, low capital cost, and modular design.

That arrangement addresses the two major challenges with flow batteries. First, vanadium doesn't degrade. "If you put 100 grams of vanadium into your battery and you come back in 100 years, you should be able to recover 100 grams of that vanadium--as long as the battery doesn't have some sort of a physical leak," says Brushett.

The expense of building a vanadium-based energy storage project is significantly more than the cost of building a lithium-based project, posing the foremost challenge for vanadium battery projects. "Building a vanadium battery costs around 3,000-4,000 yuan per kWh, while building a lithium battery costs about 1,500 yuan per kWh," a battery ...

"If you were paying for the full cost of a lithium battery, and for the full cost of a vanadium battery, you probably be ending up paying about US\$6 to US\$7 for lithium battery and probably US\$10 for VRB upfront, but over 25 years, you probably need to replace your lithium battery two to three times.
