With falling PV system and battery costs, the business case for storage is gathering pace. By the end of 2018, some 120,000 households and commercial operations had already invested in PV battery systems. Unlike other energy sources, battery storage can supply and consume energy at different times of the day, creating a combination of cost and revenue streams that makes it challenging to directly compare storage with generation-only technologies.
