

Energy storage battery packaging steps

Packaging. Packaging process refers to a process in which a battery cell and a module are combined in series

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and parallel and put them in a frame, to protect them from external impact (vibration or heat) and to increase efficiency. So an important factor in battery packaging is how much battery packs protect internal elements of the battery.
