

Battery Recycling Market Size & Trends . The result indicates that in 2020, the PbC battery emerged as the most cost-effective option. However, over time, both lithium batteries became the cheapest option with almost similar trends. As noted above, recycling"s profit is low when metal prices are low and recycling volumes are low. Using the high metal price scenario shown in the table below, mined lithium has a profit margin of up to 89 percent when considering the ratio of earnings before interest and taxes to the revenue from each ton of battery, compared to up to 19 percent for recycled lithium.
