More recently, a fire broke out an energy storage facility in Chandler, Ariz., in April 2022. A fire at a California lithium-ion battery energy storage facility once described as the world"s largest has burned for five days, prompting evacuation orders. The fire broke out on Wednesday at the 250MW Gateway Energy Storage facility owned by grid infrastructure developer LS Power in San Diego.

These battery energy storage systems usually incorporate large-scale lithium-ion battery installations to store energy for short periods. The systems are brought online during periods of low energy production and/or high demand. Their purpose is to increase the reliability of the grid and reduce the need for other drastic measures (such as rolling blackouts).

On March 3, 2022, explosion of a residential energy storage facility drew much attention in Southern Germany, for residential ESS carries much greater risks to people than outdoor ESS. According to statistics compiled by InfoLink, there have been at least 12 ESS fire accidents since 2021, among which three of them involve residential ESS in Europe.

Some of these batteries have experienced troubling fires and explosions. There have been two types of explosions; flammable gas explosions due to gases generated in battery thermal runaways, and electrical arc explosions leading to structural failure of battery electrical enclosures.
