

# Energy storage company in brazil

Vedanta Energy Storage Systems was founded in November of 2017 by Richard Phillips in São Paulo/SP, Brazil. Brazil's regulatory framework does not prohibit energy storage solutions, but there are currently no specific regulations on storage. At the end of 2023, most BESS applications in Brazil were behind the meter. There is a



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proposed law on energy storage to encourage front-of-the-meter BESS, but Congress has not prioritized its approval.
