



## Energy storage costs 2 cents

Sum the component costs to get the total BESS cost in future years. For each future year, develop a linear correlation relating BESS costs to power and energy capacity:  $\text{BESS cost (total \$)} = c_1 * P_B + c_2 * E_B + c_3$ ; Where  $P_B$  = battery power capacity (kW),  $E_B$  = battery energy storage capacity (\$/kWh), and  $c_i$  = constants specific to each ...

When evaluating whether and what type of storage system they should install, many customers only look at the initial cost of the system -- the first cost or cost per kilowatt-hour (kWh). Such thinking fails to account for other factors that impact overall system cost, known as the levelized cost of energy (LCOE), which factors in the system's useful life, operating and ...

The levelized costs are calculated based on a 30- year cost recovery period, using an after -tax weighted average cost of capital (WACC) of 6.54% for the 2028 online year. The capacity -weighted average is the average levelized cost per technology, weighted by the new capacity coming online in each region in 2028, excluding planned capacity
