6 · Look for the Energy Factor (EF) rating on the unit. This rating measures how efficiently a unit converts energy into heat as well as how much heat is lost during storage. The higher the energy factor, the more energy efficient the water heater is. Look for EF ratings as close to 1 as possible. Electric heaters tend to have the highest EF ratings.

SHS is generally composed of liquid storage tanks, pipes, storage media, packaged refrigerants or refrigeration systems, and control systems, as depicted in Fig. 8 [[100], [101], [102]]. SHS is the simplest method of storing thermal energy. It stores energy by directly heating a solid or liquid medium without phase change.

As an important side note, you must also account for the backup hot water infrastructure. If your backup is an electric water heater, proper wiring must be installed.
