The most clear-cut way to reduce losses is by replacing cables and transformers. Some of these maybe either old or less efficient assets which upgrading these to more efficient stock can substantially reduce losses. However, installation costs are often high, so generally upgrades are made when the equipment needs replacing anyway.

In a grid-tied operation, the storage system is programmed to charge and discharge at various times to help with load shedding and demand response. Typically, the system will discharge the storage system during times of high demand or when on-site production is low to help reduce the energy usage and cost of the facility.

Co-located energy storage systems are installed alongside renewable generation sources such as solar farms. Co-locating solar and storage improves project efficiency and can often reduce total expenses by sharing balance of system costs across assets. Co-located energy storage systems can be either DC or AC coupled.
