

Energy storage fully connected to the grid

Abstract: High penetration of renewable energy resources in the power system results in various new challenges for power system operators. One of the promising solutions to sustain the quality and reliability of the power system is the integration of energy storage systems (ESSs).

There is a need to scale-up energy storage to match the electricity supply with hourly, daily, and seasonal electricity demand profiles. According to the International Energy Agency, about 310 GW grid-connected electricity storage capacity will be needed by the USA, Europe, China, and India .

However, with grid infrastructure often taking five to fifteen years to plan and permit, in comparison to one to five years for new renewables projects, the current speed of grid build-out is nowhere near fast enough to manage an effective energy transition..
