1. The Pumped Storage System and Its Constituent Elements Pumped storage hydro is a mature energy storage method. It uses the characteristics of the gravitational potential energy of water for easy energy storage, with a large energy storage scale, fast adjustment speed, flexible operation and high efficiency.

Pumped hydro storage (PHS) is a form of energy storage that uses potential energy, in this case water. It is an elderly system; however, it is still widely used nowadays, because it presents a mature technology and allows a high degree of autonomy and does not require consumables, nor cutting-edge technology, in the hands of a few countries.

Pumped Hydro Energy Storage (PHES) systems exploit difference in energy potential between two different heights to storage energy. PHES systems are operated by pumping and swirling the water between two dams. Water is pumped using off-peak electricity and discharged in peak hours.

Penstock is used to connect the two reservoirs. The key components of a pumped storage power station are the hydro turbine and pump, which usually adopt the form of bladed hydraulic machinery. The pumped hydro energy storage system (PHS) is based on pumping water from one reservoir to another at a higher elevation, often during off-peak and other low electricity demand periods. When electricity is needed, water is released from the upper reservoir through a hydroelectric turbine and collected in the lower reservoir.
