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Zambia's state-owned electricity company, ZESCO Limited, commissioned the 750 MW Kafue Gorge Lower Hydropower plant in late April. The \$2 billion power project is located on the Kafue River in Chikankata District, Southern Province.

The Kariba Dam is located on the Zambezi River at the Kariba Gorge, on the border of Zambia and Zimbabwe. The Kariba North power station located on the north bank of the dam belongs to Zambia. The Kariba North power station was originally developed with 720MW of installed capacity, which was expanded to 1,080MW by adding two 180MW units in 2013.

Batoka Gorge hydropower station is a 2.4GW run-of-the river hydroelectric project planned to be developed on the Zambezi River, which flows across the boundaries of Zambia and Zimbabwe. It will be located 54km downstream of the Victoria Falls, one of the biggest waterfalls in the world.
