However, this field of electrical engineering includes a number of new specialties such as digital systems, pow-er plants, renewable energy, power electronics, energy storage, energy conservation, computer engineering, communication, networks, etc.

Applying their knowledge of power output and electronics, they help bolster the efficiency of batteries,
