Dielectric capacitors are promising candidates for high-performance energy storage systems due to their high power density and increasing energy density. 2.1 Energy storage mechanism of dielectric capacitors. Basically, a dielectric capacitor consists of two metal electrodes and an insulating dielectric layer. When an external electric field is applied to the insulating

In comparison to various electrical storage devices like batteries, dielectric capacitors possess the capability to discharge stored energy in an extremely brief timeframe (microseconds), resulting in the generation of substantial power pulses.

2.3. Energy storage testing The energy storage performance of polymer dielectric capacitor mainly refers to the electric energy that can be charged/discharged under applied or removed electric field. There are currently two mainstream methods for testing capacitor performance.
