The correct insulation of the winding of a motor is determined by both the temperature rise in the motor and the temperature of the ambient air. If a motor is subjected to an ambient temperature higher than 40 o C, it must normally be de-rated or a higher insulation class of material used.

The selection of insulation class is critical to the life of the motor. A common rule of thumb is that the life of the motor insulation will be halved for every 8 to 10 &#176;C it is operated above the rated insulation temperature
