

These two distinct energy storage mechanisms are represented in electric circuits by two ideal circuit elements: the ideal capacitor and the ideal inductor, which approximate the behavior of actual discrete capacitors and inductors. They also approximate the bulk properties of capacitance and inductance that are present in any physical system.

In electrical engineering, a capacitor is a device that stores electrical energy by accumulating electric charges on two closely spaced surfaces that are insulated from each other. The capacitor was originally known as the condenser, [1] a term still encountered in a few compound names, such as the condenser microphone is a passive electronic component with two terminals.

Batteries have a weakness stemming from the way they are designed. Batteries struggle to deliver energy quickly. Delivering energy quickly, which is needed to level a load or provide the burst of current needed to turn on a motor, can waste the battery's capacity and put stress on the battery that shortens its operating life.

An electric vehicle consists of power electronic converters, energy storage system, electric motor and electronic controllers [15]. Hannan et al. [16] presented a detailed review on ESS technologies, their characteristics, evaluation processes, classifications and energy conversion for EV applications.

Super-capacitor energy storage, battery energy storage, and flywheel energy storage have the advantages of strong climbing ability, flexible power output, fast response speed, and strong plasticity [7]. More development is needed for electromechanical storage coming from batteries and flywheels [8].

Energy Density vs. Power Density in Energy Storage . Supercapacitors are best in situations that benefit from short bursts of energy and rapid charge/discharge cycles. They excel in power density, absorbing energy in short bursts, but they have lower energy density compared to batteries (Figure 1). They can't store as much energy for long ...
