Figure 2: Cumulative installed capacity of new energy storage projects commissioned in China (as of the end of June 2023) In the first half of 2023, China's new energy storage continued to develop at a high speed, with 850 projects (including planning, under construction and commissioned projects), more than twice that of the same period last year.

In terms of installed capacity, China's energy storage market has reached a new high in the first half of 24, with a total installed capacity of 14.40GW/35. 39GWh, which has reached 69% of the annual installed capacity in 23 years.

The global energy storage deployment is expected to grow steadily in the coming decade. In 2022, the annual growth rate of pumped storage hydropower capacity grazed 10 percent, while the cumulative capacity of battery power storage is forecast to surpass 500 gigawatts by 2045.

As of the end of 2022, the total nameplate power capacity of operational utility-scale battery energy storage systems (BESSs) in the United States was 8,842 MW and the total energy capacity was 11,105 MWh. Most of the BESS power capacity that was operational in 2022 was installed after 2014, and about 4,807 MW was installed in 2022 alone.

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In 2020, installed capacity and power generation capacity of renewable energy in China will increase by 17.5% and 8.4% respectively. In the first half of 2023, the United States saw significant growth in its utility energy storage capacity and reserves: According to S& P Global's forecast, the new installed capacity of U.S. utility energy storage (battery storage) is projected to reach 3.50GW in Q3 2023, marking an 81% increase compared to the previous quarter.

3 ¶; A long-term trajectory for Energy Storage Obligations (ESO) has also been notified by the Ministry of Power to ensure that sufficient storage capacity is available with obligated entities. As per the trajectory, the ESO shall gradually increase from 1% in FY 2023-24 to 4% by FY 2029-30, with an annual increase of 0.5%.

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
