A good rule of thumb is that grid-scale lithium ion batteries will have 4-hours of storage duration, as this minimizes per kW costs and maximizes the revenue potential from power price arbitrage.

For example, a battery with 1 MW of power capacity and 4 MWh of usable energy capacity will have a storage duration of four hours. Cycle life/lifetime is the amount of time or cycles a battery storage system can provide regular charging and discharging before failure or significant degradation.

300 MWh is perhaps big or even "huge" for a battery storage but not generally for storing energy. 300 MWh is about the energy that a typical nuclear power plant delivers in 20 minutes. A modern pumped hydro storage, for example (Nant-de-Dranse, Switzerland), stores about 20 GWh (with turbines for 900 MW) what is about 67 times the 300 MWh.

Base year costs for utility-scale battery energy storage systems (BESS) are based on a bottom-up cost model using the data and methodology for utility-scale BESS in (Ramasamy et al., 2021).
