

Large-scale integration of renewable energy in China has had a major impact on the balance of supply and demand in the power system. It is crucial to integrate energy storage devices within wind power and photovoltaic (PV) stations to effectively manage the impact of large-scale renewable energy generation on power balance and grid reliability.

In 2019, Lao PDR's total primary energy supply (TPES) was 5.9 million tonnes of oil equivalent (Mtoe), and the energy mix consisted of hydropower, oil, coal, solar and biomass. As there were many power plants in Lao PDR generating electricity for export in 2019, the export figure reached 25,048 gigawatt-hours (GWh) or equivalent to 2.15 Mtoe.

This laid the foundation for the two-way power trade between China and Laos. According to the arrangement, China and Laos agreed to send surplus hydropower from the Nam Tha River Hydropower Station to Yunnan for consumption during the rainy season, while China will supplement power to the undersupplied areas in northern Laos during the dry season.

Every year the Lao PDR receives a significant amount of hard currencies from those power exports. This is widely considered to be one of the driving forces to boost socioeconomic development and energy security in the country. The Lao PDR's total final energy consumption (TFEC) grew by 2.7% from 2010 to 2018 (Figure 10.1).

The FPV project envisages the construction and installation of a 240 MWp floating solar plant covering an area of about 3.2 square kilometers, at the Nam Theun 2 hydropower station in Laos. The project is owned by Laos State Electricity Corporation, Electricite du Laos (EDL). It is being developed by a joint venture of EDL (20%) and Sinohydro (80%), a subsidiary of Power China, under a 25-year build, operate and transfer (BOT) agreement signed in April 2011. The estimated investment in the project is £2.1bn (\$2.73bn).

Of this amount, 77.59 percent will come from hydropower and the rest will come from solar, wind and coal-fired power plants, said the report. Laos' capacity for solar power is expected to range from 10,000 MW to 15,000 MW, while wind power potential is estimated at about 100,000 MW, according to the report.

On November 16, Fujian GW-level Ningde Xiapu Energy Storage Power Station (Phase I) of State Grid Times successfully transmitted power. The project is mainly invested by State Grid Integrated Energy and CATL, which is the largest single grid-side standalone station-type electrochemical energy storage power station in China so far.
