

Energy storage project in cold regions

The differentiated physical environment requirements within the internal space of ice rinks in cold regions result in a complex heat exchange process, which becomes the primary cause of high energy consumption. Therefore, analyzing the impact mechanisms of spatial layout parameters on the energy consumption of ice rinks is crucial during the early design stages.

The Renewable Energy and Energy Efficiency Partnership estimated the potential of solar cold storage for perishables in Uganda and found that despite improving agricultural production (reducing post-harvest losses), solar cold storage will be able to save >100 000 tonnes (equivalent) of CO₂ emissions a year by 2030; this avoids GHG emissions.

Mono-well systems separate hot and cold storage vertically through a single well resulting in reduced drilling costs and space requirements [23], although require an aquifer with a greater thickness to effectively separate the hot and cold regions and avoid thermal interaction. Fig. 1 below indicates the difference between the two arrangements.

It is advisable to use traditional or new windows with thermal insulation and shuttered windows. Furthermore, the optimal position of the long side of the granary was between 10° west and 10° east of north. This research could provide guidance for the energy-saving design and renovation of granary buildings in cold regions of China.

In summary, the work of Lu and co-workers extends the operational range of RFBs to frigid temperatures. This enhanced performance range is enabled through the combination of a POM structure and judicious counter-ion choice.
