



Energy storage project put into production

The first phase of the world's largest sodium-ion battery energy storage system (BESS), in China, has come online. The first 50MW/100MWh portion of the project in Qianjiang, Hubei province has been completed and put into operation, state-owned media outlet Yicai Global and technology provider HiNa Battery said this week.

With a recent report concluding that most fossil fuel power plants in the U.S. will reach the end of their working life by 2035, experts say that the time for rapid growth in industrial-scale energy storage is at hand.

As far as China's energy storage market is concerned, according to incomplete statistics, during January-February 2024, China put into operation 99 new energy storage projects, with a total scale of nearly 3GW, totaling 2.912GW/7.743GWh, of which due to reasons such as some of the projects were not completed at the end of 2023, the scale of the ...

The 60 MW energy storage installed in the first phase of the project has been officially incorporated into the State Grid Corporation of China (SGCC) and put into operation on May 26, 2022. In addition, the long-term planned construction scale is 1,000 MW.

They are located in the SE3 and SE4 electricity price areas of the Swedish grid, the most southern of its four areas (SE1-SE4).
