RBS tops its other contending energy recovery systems. RBSs can be classified based on employed energy storage system and control system. RBSs improve fuel economy, performance, and reduce emissions and brake wear. Evaluation factors that determine RBS effectiveness are presented.

ESSs are primarily designed to harvest energy from various sources, transforming and storing the energy as needed for diverse uses. Because of the large variety of available ESSs with various applications, numerous authors have reviewed ESSs from various angles in the literature.

Mechanical energy storage (MES) system In the MES system, the energy is stored by transforming between

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mechanical and electrical energy forms . When the demand is low during off-peak hours, the electrical energy consumed by the power source is converted and stored as mechanical energy in the form of potential or kinetic energy.

There are three types of kinetic energy recovery systems available currently -- the mechanical energy storage system in the form of a flywheel, hydraulic system and an electrical energy storage system in the form of battery or ultra capacitor.

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
