A Proton Exchange Membrane (PEM)-based RFC system integrates a fuel cell, an electrolyzer, and a multi-fluid reactant storage system into an energy storage device. The energy capacity of the RFC is determined by the amount of available hydrogen and oxygen storage.

We estimate that by 2040, LDES deployment could result in the avoidance of 1.5 to 2.3 gigatons of CO₂ equivalent per year, or around 10 to 15 percent of today's power sector emissions. In the United States alone, LDES could reduce the overall cost of achieving a fully decarbonized power system by around \$35 billion annually by 2040.
