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EPRI's battery energy storage system database has tracked over 50 utility-scale battery failures, most of which occurred in the last four years. One fire resulted in life-threatening injuries to first responders. These incidents represent a 1 to 2 percent failure rate across the 12.5 GWh of lithium-ion battery energy storage worldwide.

Additional ESS-specific guidance is provided in the NFPA Energy Storage Systems Safety Fact Sheet [B10]. NFPA 855 requires several submittals to the authority having jurisdiction (AHJ), all of which should be available to the pre-incident plan developer. NYSERDA published the Battery Energy Storage System Guidebook, most-recently updated in December 2020, which contains information and step-by-step instructions to support local governments in New York in managing the development of residential, commercial, and utility-scale BESS in their communities.

It is recognized that electric energy storage equipment or systems can be a single device providing all required functions or an assembly of components, each having limited functions. Components having limited functions shall be tested for those functions in accordance with this standard.



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For the purposes of this guide, a facility is assumed to be subject to the 2023 revision of NFPA 855 [B8]1 and to have a battery housed in a number of outdoor enclosures with total energy exceeding 600 kWh, thus triggering requirements for a hazard mitigation analysis (HMA), fire and explosion testing in accordance with UL 9540A [B14 ...

This document provides an overview of current codes and standards (C+S) applicable to U.S. installations of utility-scale battery energy storage systems. This overview highlights the most impactful documents and is not intended to be exhaustive.

As shown in Fig. 3, many safety C& S affect the design and installation of ESS. One of the key product standards that covers the full system is the UL9540 Standard for Safety: Energy Storage Systems and Equipment [1]. Here, we discuss this standard in detail; some of the remaining challenges are discussed in the next section.

There are other requirements in IRC Section R328 that are not within the scope of this bulletin.
