

Silver is a good example, with sintered layers achieving a thermal conductivity of 140-200 W/(m·K). When heated, the copper in the outer layer of sterling silver oxidizes, forming firescale, a layer of dull grey material on the outside of the silver. While flux helps mitigate firescale, chemical removal with an acid pickle solution is necessary (called so for its former main ingredient alum, used to make pickles). Sure, you could sand away the grey surface layer, but it would take extra time ...

Initially I tried using silver solder paste from CooksonGold. This silver solder paste works really well using a blowtorch. However, in the kiln it just turns into a gritty dried out paste. The first time was using a programmed ramp in the Prometheus kiln to 720°C. The second attempt used the oven pre-heated to 720°C.
