ESS is defined by two key characteristics - power capacity in Watt and storage capacity in Watt-hour.



Energy storage capacity is a battery's capacity. As batteries age, this trait declines. The battery SoH can be best estimated by empirically evaluating capacity declining over time. A lithium-ion battery was charged and discharged till its end of life.
