There are two basic Thermal Energy Storage (TES) Strategies, latent heat systems and sensible heat systems. Stratification is used within the tank as a strategy for thermal layering of the stored water. Colder water is denser and will settle toward the bottom of the tank, while the warmer water will naturally seek to rise to the top.

Thermal Storage Benefits. Thermal Energy Storage (TES) is a technology whereby thermal energy is produced during off-peak hours and stored for use during peak demand. TES is most widely used to produce chilled water during those off-peak times to provide cooling when the need for both cooling and power peak, thereby increasing efficiency.. The storage volume ranges from 2 to 4 ft<sup>3</sup>/ton-hour for ice systems, compared to 15 ft<sup>3</sup>/ton-hour for a chilled water. The application for energy storage systems varies by industry, and can include district cooling, data centers, combustion turbine plants, and the use of hot water TES systems.

When charging the tank, the warm water is taken from the top of the tank and sent to the chiller, while the chilled water is returned to the tank near the bottom. Chilled water storage tanks require a large footprint to store the large volume of water required for these systems.
