501.3 Drain valves. Drain valves for emptying shall be installed at the bottom of each tank-type water heater and hot water storage tank. The drain valve inlet shall be not less than 3 / 4-inch (19 mm) nominal iron pipe size and the outlet shall be provided with male garden hose threads.

In many cases an inexpensive water tank will suffice as a storage means however they lack the sophistication that a proper storage tank can provide. Dedicated geothermal, solar thermal or Air source heat pump tanks will help to maximize the energy performance including features such as higher insulation, immersion probes for temperature sensors ...

Where a storage tank-type water heater or a hot water storage tank is installed in a location where water leakage from the tank will cause damage, the tank shall be installed in a galvanized steel pan having a material thickness of not less than 0.0236 inch (0.6010 mm) (No. 24 gage), or other pans approved for such use.

Next, connect a garden hose to the water heater's drain valve and run it to your drain or receptacle. Open the drain valve manually or with a flathead screwdriver to release water from the tank. Sometimes, sediment buildup inside the tank can clog the drain valve and prevent you from removing the water.
