Performance testing is a critical component of safe and reliable deployment of energy storage systems on the electric power grid. Specific performance tests can be applied to individual battery cells or to integrated energy storage systems.

Large-scale energy storage is so-named to distinguish it from small-scale energy storage (e.g., batteries, capacitors, and small energy tanks). The advantages of large-scale energy storage are its capacity to accommodate many energy carriers, its high security over decades of service time, and its acceptable construction and economic management.
