

In Bloomberg New Energy Finance (BNEF) 2020 ranking of global wind turbine manufacturers, 7 of the top 10 wind turbine manufacturers are Chinese companies, with Goldwind of China in second place behind General Electric of the United States.

According to BloombergNEF (BNEF), developers commissioned 60.7 GW in 2019 compared with 50 GW in 2018. Most of these were on land (88%), but the share of turbines installed offshore is growing, up four percentage points to 12%. Vestas was the world's leading turbine maker again in 2019.

Xinjiang Goldwind Science & Technology (SHE:002202) retained the top spot with 16.4 GW of projects commissioned last year. Envision Energy rose to second place with 15.4 GW, while Denmark's Vestas Wind Systems A/S (CPH:VWS) ranked third with 13.4 GW. Windey and Mingyang rounded off the top five.
