For the 14th Five-Year Plan, the China State Council set a national target of installing 30 gigawatts (GW) of non-hydro energy storage by 2025, while provincial goals were more ambitious. Clear policy guidance and strong renewables growth make energy storage a rising star in China's clean energy technology industry.

Construction risks: It is common practice to see multiple equipment supply, construction, and installation contracts rather than one turnkey engineering, procurement, and construction (EPC) contract for energy storage projects.

The auction attracted highly competitive bids, with tariffs reaching as low as INR 3.41/kWh. Pace Digitek Infra secured the lowest bid, winning a 100 MW project at INR 3.41/kWh. JSW Neo Energy clinched 500 MW at INR 3.42/kWh, although this was slightly lower than their initial bid for 600 MW.
