2. ENERGY STORAGE FORMULA. Central to the understanding of energy storage in capacitors is the formula used to calculate the energy stored within a capacitor, expressed as  $E = 1/2 C V^2$ . In this equation, E is the energy in joules, C represents capacitance in farads, and V denotes voltage in volts.

The voltage  $V$  is proportional to the amount of charge which is already on the capacitor.

The energy storage density of the metadielectric film capacitors can achieve to 85 joules per cubic centimeter with energy efficiency exceeding 81% in the temperature range from 25 °C to 400 °C.
