Yes, you can connect your laptop charger to an electrical outlet in Finland as long as the outlet is compatible with the charger's voltage and plug type. In Finland, the standard voltage is 230V and the standard frequency is 50Hz.

All power sockets in Finland provide a standard voltage of 230V with a standard frequency of 50Hz. You can use all your equipment in Finland if the outlet voltage in your own country is between 220V-240V. This is the case in most of Europe, Australia, the United Kingdom and most countries in Africa and Asia.
