The total thermal capacity of the fully charged seasonal thermal energy storage is 90 gigawatt-hours. This capacity could heat a medium-sized Finnish city for as long as a year. Broken down into smaller energy units, this amount of energy is equivalent to, for example, 1.3 million electric car batteries.

EPV is studying solar energy yield at its own solar power measuring facility. As a pioneer in zero-emission energy generation, EPV is constantly researching renewable energy technologies and energy production on the market. One example of this is the solar energy measuring station in Vuorenneva, Alavus, commissioned in September 2018.

The companies report that the initial designs should be authorized and ready for construction in 2025. "A photovoltaic capacity of 600 MW means an electricity production of approximately 780,000 MWh, which, once operational, will generate enough renewable energy for the equivalent of approximately 200,000 European households.
