

# French hydrogen storage

The green hydrogen plant is being built in Le Cheylas, at the former Ascom's steelworks waste storage site, on a 7,000 m<sup>2</sup> plot of land. The project will contribute to the reindustrialization of this brownfield site, initiated by its current owner SLS Actiparc Sillon Alpin.

This is an important proof point for the use of hydrogen storage and electrical regeneration combined with renewable energy. The \$200 million French Guiana CEOG project will combine a solar park, long-term hydrogen and short-term battery storage and fuel cells specified by HDF, based on Ballard's ClearGen architecture.

Hydrogen can be stored physically as either a gas or a liquid. Storage of hydrogen as a gas typically requires high-pressure tanks (350-700 bar [5,000-10,000 psi] tank pressure). Storage of hydrogen as a liquid requires cryogenic temperatures because the boiling point of hydrogen at one atmosphere pressure is -252.8°C.

Hydrogen is already in wide use as an industrial chemical, and storage has been a long-standing problem. The primary solution to date has been to compress hydrogen at up to 700 bar, some 50 times the pressure of an outdoor grill's propane tank. But the high-pressure tanks are costly, and energy-guzzling compressors are needed to fill them.

A EUR4 billion support mechanism will ensure the competitiveness of low-carbon hydrogen compared with fossil hydrogen over 10 years. It also outlines an openness to the world strategy. It supports the French industry in its international commercial development, assuming the emergence of a global market for hydrogen and its derivatives.
