The installed capacity of energy storage refers to 1. the maximum amount of energy that a storage system can hold, 2. the ability of that system to release energy to the grid when required, 3. its value in enhancing the reliability and efficiency of power systems, and 4. how it supports the integration of renewable energy sources. 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Batteries are typically employed for sub-hourly, hourly and daily balancing. Total installed grid-scale battery storage capacity stood at close to 28 GW at the end of 2022, most of which was added over the course of the previous 6 years. Compared with 2021, installations rose by more than 75% in 2022, as around 11 GW of storage capacity was added.

where $P(x)$ is the price per energy or power capacity of a storage technology (US\$ kWh⁻¹, US\$ kW⁻¹) at the cumulatively installed energy or power capacity X (kWh, kW) of that technology.

Different studies have analysed the likely future paths for the deployment of energy storage in the EU. These studies point to more than 200 GW and 600 GW of energy storage capacity by 2030 and 2050 respectively (from roughly 60 GW in 2022, mainly in the form of pumped hydro storage).

The installed capacity of energy storage in the first quarter of 2023 surged to an impressive 792.3 MW/2144.5 MWh, according to data from Wood Mackenzie. This reflects a year-on-year increase of 6.1%. However, it's important to note a 10.6% decrease compared to the previous year and a substantial quarter-on-quarter decrease of 25.7% and 29.2%.
