

RWE has begun construction of one of Germany's largest battery storage facilities at its power plant locations in Neurath and Hamm. The facility will have a capacity of 220 megawatts (MW) and storage capacity of 235 megawatt hours (MWh).

Multinational utility and independent power producer (IPP) RWE has started building its first battery energy storage system (BESS) project in the Netherlands. The Germany-headquartered company announced the start of construction on the BESS at its Eemshaven biomass and gas power plant complex, near Groningen, last week (8 February).

Construction work on RWE's largest battery storage project in Germany to date is making swift progress. With 690 battery blocks, a storage capacity of 235 megawatt hours and an output of 220 megawatts (MW), RWE Generation is building one of the largest battery storage systems in Germany.

German wind and solar parks operator Encavis AG announced on Monday the start of construction works on its first battery energy storage system (BESS) project, a 12-MW/24-MWh facility in Hettstedt, Germany. "The Hettstedt BESS is a landmark project for Encavis and represents our strategic move into energy storage," the company noted in a social media post.

System integrator Eco Stor is planning to build a 300MW/600MWh battery energy storage system (BESS) in Saxony-Anhalt, Germany, one of the largest projects in Europe. The project will be completed in 2025, managing director Georg Gallmetzer told German press last week, and will require an investment of around EUR250 million (US\$280 million).

Eco Stor has unveiled plans for its largest battery energy storage system to date in capacity terms. The German-Norwegian developer aims to build a 300 MW/716 MWh standalone battery storage facility in the municipality of Trossingen in southwestern Germany. The construction is scheduled to begin mid-2027, the company announced earlier this week.

The battery storage project will be located in Alfeld (Leine), Lower Saxony, Germany. According to the project development company of large-scale battery energy storage systems, the facility will be the largest approved storage project on the continent to date, surpassing the current record holder in Europe by 50%.

The firm is planning to start construction on two larger systems this year as well, 300MW/600MWh projects in Rhineland-Palatinate and Saxony-Anhalt. Eco Stor managing director Georg Gallmetzer has previously told Energy-Storage.news that the firm manages all parts of the project lifecycle and value chain with the exception of route-to-market (RTM).

Roger Miesen, CEO RWE Generation: "As the proportion of renewables in the electricity mix increases, so does the need for flexible battery storage systems. They balance out fluctuations in the electricity grid in seconds, which means they are the key to a reliable electricity supply.

For energy storage projects the Federal Government has also provided for exemptions from surcharges and taxes. Project developers that meet the requirements can apply for loans for up to 150 million EUR from the KfW under a Standard Programme for Renewable Energies for the construction of renewable energy projects, including storage projects.
