Developer Kyon Energy has claimed the largest approved BESS in Europe for a 275MWh project in Germany, just as regulators extend grid fee exemptions for energy storage by three years to 2029. Kyon has received approval for a 137.5MW/275MWh battery energy storage system (BESS) project in Germany, it said today (13 November).

According to Germany's economy and energy ministry, these amounted to over 10.3 billion euros in 2018 alone. In 2021, renewable power operators received a direct state subsidy for the first time, amounting to 10.8 billion euros before the renewables levy was abolished entirely in 2022 and all costs were covered directly from the state budget.

Conversely, Germany opted to phase out nuclear power already in the year 2000 and completed its "nuclear exit" in April 2023, after a short delay caused by the energy crisis. In France, coal-fired power generation also has been reduced greatly in the past decades and as of 2023, only four plants were in operation in the country.

As a core plank of the Energiewende, Germany plans to further expand the role of renewables in electricity generation. Specifically, in the 2010 Energy Concept, the country aimed for renewables to account for 35% of gross electricity consumption by 2020 and overachieved this with 38% in 2018 and 44% in the first half of

2019.

The installed capacity of German pumped storage is around 6 GW. After an export surplus of 27.1 TWh was achieved in electricity trading in 2022, there was an import surplus of 11.7 TWh in 2023. This was mainly due to the lower electricity generation costs in neighboring European countries in the summer and the high cost of CO₂ certificates.
