During the week to May 13, Germany's solar farms produced 17,531 megawatt hours (MWh) of electricity, according to data from LSEG, 40% more than the week before and nearly 50% more than the long-term average for that particular week. A recent stretch of clear and sunny skies have driven the solar surge, which typically peaks around 12-1 p.m.

In 2023, renewables accounted for a record share of 59.7 percent of the net public net electricity generation in Germany. Image: Sungrow. The German Federal Network Agency (Bundesnetzagentur) has awarded 587MW of solar-plus-storage in its latest innovation tender. As has been the case in many of Germany's recent solar PV auctions, the innovation tender ended up oversubscribed, with 154 bids made for 1.8GW of capacity out of 583MW tendered capacity.

That means that solar accounted for nearly two-thirds of Germany's total electricity output during that hour, vastly exceeding output from all other sources including 17% from wind farms and a combined 12% from coal and natural gas plants.

Germans with solar storage systems below 30 kilowatts will receive subsidies that could cover 30 percent of their battery system's cost. By the integration of seasonal heat storage, more than 50% of the annual heating demand for space heating and domestic hot water can be supplied by solar energy. Since 1995, eight central solar heating plants with seasonal heat storage have been built in Germany within the governmental R& D-programme "Solarthermie-2000".

That made renewables more expensive, and the industry collapsed.
