To calculate the amount of potential energy stored in a 1-ton weight (2000 pounds) lifted to a height of 20 feet, Potential Energy (PE) = mass \cdot acceleration due to gravity \cdot height. 1 ton = 2000 pounds = 2000 lbs Height = 20 feet. 1 pound = 0.453592 kilograms 1 foot = 0.3048 meters

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
