With the rapid development of vehicle-to-grid (V2G) technology, fast charging technology and energy storage battery technology, energy optimization is important for the efficient use of renewable energy in PV and BESS-integrated fast charging stations. Economic dispatch is a hot spot for research.

A key characteristic is ensuring power quality and grid stability. This involves maintaining voltage stability, minimizing voltage deviations and power losses, managing reactive power, and addressing the effect of renewable energy integration and EV charging on grid stability and power quality.

For predictive maintenance, and to be sure the energy and power flows are properly managed, knowing the battery SOC and SOH means being able to predict and adjust the algorithms involved in the grid stabilization, in the EV charging process, and in the vehicle-to-grid (V2G) connection where the vehicles are also seen as storage units.

A representation of the DC-Fast charger with BESS is presented in Figure 2. The idea behind using DC-fast charging with a battery energy storage system (BESS) is to supply the EV from both grid and the battery at the



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same time . This way the demand from the grid is smaller.

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
