



Haiti's new energy and energy storage

According to the United States Department of Energy's Energy Information Administration, Haiti's primary energy source is electricity. The country consumes 330 million kilowatt-hours (kWh), about the total amount of electricity of 30,000 US households. Haiti has no petroleum production, refinery capacity, or reserves.

The economy in Haiti has a heavy reliance on fossil fuel energy which is entirely imported. But rising energy prices caused by the recent global social and economic turmoil have hit the domestic energy market hard. Today, Haiti sees some of the highest diesel costs in the world, peaking at \$15 per gallon.

For Haiti's President, who has made the provision of energy nationwide the cornerstone of his presidency, the promise has taken on added urgency as the nation approaches general elections slated for 2021.
