Pumped hydroelectric storage is currently the only commercially proven large-scale (>100 MW) energy storage technology with over 200 plants installed worldwide with a total installed capacity of over 100 GW. The fundamental principle of pumped hydroelectric storage is to store electric energy in the form of hydraulic potential energy.

And Chinese money lies behind British company Havana Energy's pioneering joint venture with the Cuban government to create biomass power stations that will burn sugar cane waste and marabu wood. Havana Energy, part of the Escensia group, works in the Cuban tourism, trade and energy sectors.

Two Canadian companies are currently active in the RES sector in Cuba. Deltro Group Ltd. from Ontario has signed a BOO (build, own and operate) contract with UNE (Unión Eléctrica) to build and run a 100 Mw solar farm and a 50 Mw Battery Energy Storage System.

The Nant de Drance pumped storage hydropower plant in Switzerland can store surplus energy from wind, solar, and other clean sources by pumping water from a lower reservoir to an upper one, 425 meters higher.

Pumped-storage technology is an attractive alternative, given the region's hydropower potential, existing installed capacity, and technical knowledge and experience. In 1939, the first pumped-storage plant was inaugurated in Brazil, and three additional ones were built and began commercial operation before 1955.

New pumped storage plants take longer than that to license and build, cost billions, and can last a century--a virtue, but also a commitment that takes nerve in a rapidly changing market. It's possible utilities will be spared that choice by long-duration storage technologies that are still being developed.

Pumped storage hydroelectric projects have been providing energy storage capacity and transmission grid ancillary benefits in the United States and Europe since the 1920s (Energy Storage Association n.d.). 2 percent of the capacity of the electrical system (U.S. Energy Information Administration 2020).

Pumped hydro energy storage is by far the largest, lowest cost, and most technically mature electrical storage technology. Closed-loop pumped hydro storage located away from rivers ("off-river") overcomes the problem of finding suitable sites.

The DOE data is current as of February 2020 (Sandia 2020). Pumped hydro makes up 152 GW or 96% of worldwide energy storage capacity operating today. Of the remaining 4% of capacity, the largest technology shares are molten salt (33%) and lithium-ion batteries (25%).

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
