Globally, Gatti projects rapid growth in energy storage, reaching 1.2 terawatts (1,200 gigawatts) over the next decade. Key players include Australia, which in 2017 became the first nation to install major battery storage on its grid with the 100-megawatt Hornsdale Power Reserve, and is now planning to add another 300 megawatts near Victoria.

In Fig. 2 it is noted that pumped storage is the most dominant technology used accounting for about 90.3% of the storage capacity, followed by EES. By the end of 2020, the cumulative installed capacity of EES had reached 14.2 GW. The lithium-iron battery accounts for 92% of EES, followed by NaS battery at 3.6%, lead battery which accounts for about 3.5%, ...



Grid-scale battery storage in particular needs to grow significantly. In the Net Zero Scenario, installed grid-scale battery storage capacity expands 35-fold between 2022 and 2030 to nearly 970 GW. Around 170 GW of capacity is added in 2030 alone, up from 11 GW in 2022.

Grid-scale storage, particularly batteries, will be essential to manage the impact on the power grid and handle the hourly and seasonal variations in renewable electricity output while keeping grids stable and reliable in the face of growing demand. Grid-scale battery storage needs to grow significantly to get on track with the Net Zero Scenario.

Implicit in that statement is the idea that batteries can (and should) help lower grid emissions, increase the integration of zero-emissions renewable energy sources, and support overall power sector decarbonization.
