

How do electricity users store energy

The electricity enters the inverter to be converted into AC electricity the home can use. Excess electricity then flows through another inverter to change back into DC electricity that can be stored for later. If the house needs to use the energy stored in the battery, that electricity must flow through the inverter again to become AC electricity.

Electrical energy is stored during times when electricity is plentiful and inexpensive (especially from variable renewable energy sources such as wind power and solar power) or when demand is low, and later returned to the grid when demand is high, and electricity prices tend to be higher.

A consortium of utilities in Iowa, Minnesota, and the Dakotas is already working with the U.S.'s Sandia National Laboratories to develop a giant, 268-megawatt compressed air system. Called the Iowa Stored Energy Park, it would store excess energy from the region's burgeoning wind industry.
