



How does the energy storage plant work

Types of power plants Steam turbine. Most traditional power plants make energy by burning fuel to release heat. For that reason, they're called thermal (heat-based) power plants. Pumped storage is a method of keeping water in reserve for peak period power demands by pumping water that has already flowed through the turbines back up a storage pool above the power plant at a time when customer demand for energy is low, such as during the middle of the night.

Some CSP plants can take that energy and store it for when irradiance levels are low. This is why concentrated solar power is a viable utility-scale electricity generating option. There are four different types of plants used around the world to create electricity- parabolic dishes, solar power towers, parabolic troughs, and linear fresnel systems.
