Intermittency characteristic of renewable energy sources can be resolved using an energy storage technology.



The function of the energy storage system is to store the excess energy that is produced from various renewable energy sources during the off-peak hours and releases the same energy during the peak hours.

The efficiency of the system consists of the conversion efficiency of pressure potential energy within the cylinders into kinetic energy within the discharged air, and also the mechanical efficiency of the air turbines handling the ultimate energy conversion into electricity.
