

# How much does container energy storage cost

At battery prices of US\$100 kWh<sup>-1</sup>, the TCP of a battery-electric containership is lower than that of an ICE equivalent over routes of less than 1,000 km--without considering the costs of environmental and health damages.

The most common sizes for used shipping containers are 20 feet and 40 feet, each catering to different storage needs and spatial constraints. The cost of shipping containers varies widely based on type and size. Generally, a 20-foot standard container costs between \$2,000 and \$4,000, while a 40-foot standard container ranges from \$3,500 to \$6,000.

Cost metrics are approached from the viewpoint of the final downstream entity in the energy storage project, ultimately representing the final project cost. This framework helps eliminate current inconsistencies associated with specific cost categories (e.g., energy storage racks vs. energy storage modules).
