Thermal energy can be stored as sensible heat in a material by raising its temperature. The heat or energy storage can be calculated as $q = V r c p dt = m c p dt$ (1) where . q = sensible heat stored in the material (J, Btu) V = volume of substance (m³, ft³) r = density of substance (kg/m³, lb/ft³)
