You can then compare this to how much you currently pay. Some suppliers will change your meter for free. You can also change your meter to get off Economy 7 - most big suppliers will do it for free, including British Gas, EDF, E.on Next and Ovo. If your provider does charge, you could switch to one that doesn"t.

Automatic meters are usually designed to store energy in the form of electrical data. The storage capacity typically ranges from 3 to 10 kilowatt-hours for most residential meters, which allows for short-term energy usage tracking and data management.

This is a measurement of how much energy the appliance uses on average each second, so a 100 watt lamp uses 100 joules of energy each second. To find out how much that costs, you need to figure out how much energy you"d use if you left the appliance on for an hour. That gives you a measurement in kilowatt hours. (A kilowatt is 1000 watts.)
